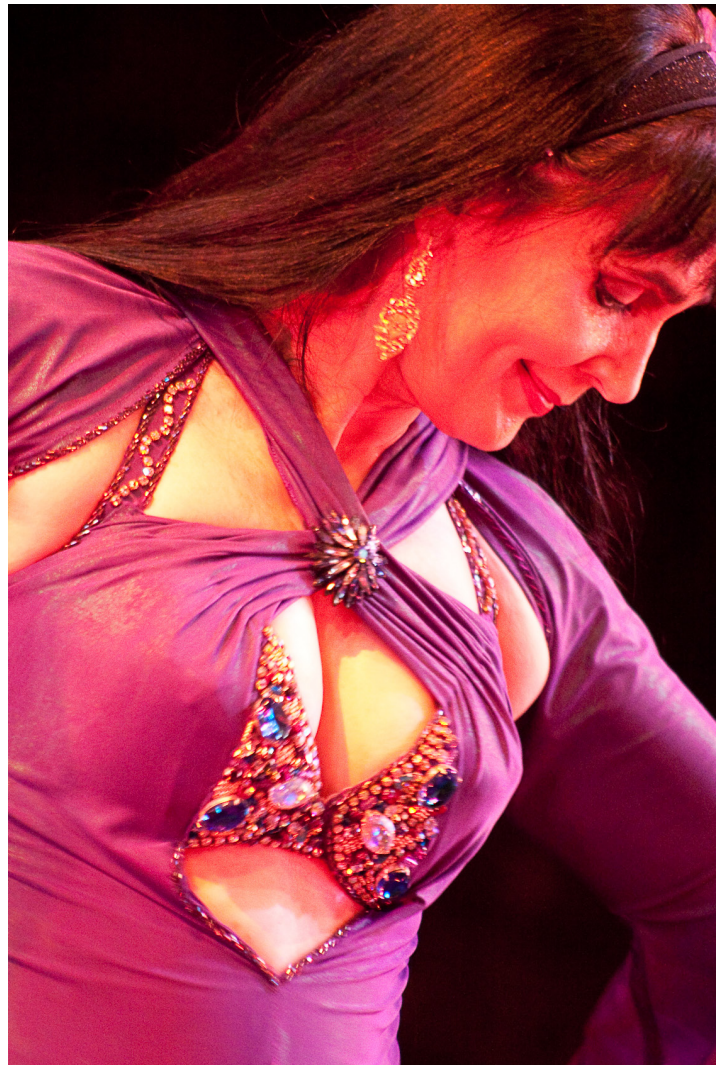

8 am - 10 am: Registration & vendors open

Classes are appropriate for all levels beginner to professional; Cassandra will layer and provide variations for all movements so that beginners are welcome and comfortable; while the "pros" are gently pushed and challenged.

SATURDAY EVENING PERFORMANCE:

The Saturday evening performance gala, "Alf Laila wa Laila: One Thousand and One Nights" will be presented courtesy of the Crown Royal Plaza in Downtown Toledo, in the Grand Ballroom, and will feature invited talent from (literally!) around the globe, the highlight being a performance by the incomparable Cassandra. There will be a short intermission; also, a cash bar and complimentary hors d'oevrs will be available to guests through out the show. The program is presented in conjunction with Independent Advocates, a local organization focusing on legally championing battered women, and prevention of violence against women. A portion of all proceeds will be donated to IA.

Tickets are \$20 in advance; \$25 the day of show, and at the door. There is limited seating and we plan to sell out, so buy early if you plan to attend.

SATURDAY-DAY 1

CLASS 1

"Rhythm Reaction" Do you ever wonder what movement or combination fits best with certain drum beats or lyrical orchestration? Do you "stall" or get stumped occasionally by variations of a rhythm? Cassandra will focus on specific drum rhythms (Malfuf, Beledi, Ayoub, Masmoudi, etc.) accompanied by a live drummer; and the dance movements and different variations of these within this medium.

CLASS 2

"Combinations & Improvisation" Cassandra will focus on teaching specific combinations that you can then mix and match, and use to create *your own* "improvisational choreographies" that best fit with whatever musical phrasing, melody, and rhythms you might be working with. In addition, she will then focus on graceful segues and transitions to keep the flow of your dance smooth and seamless.

SUNDAY-DAY 2

CLASS 1

ZILLS! A MUST for the well-rounded and serious dancer! Finger cymbal patterns along with complementary drum rhythms, combined with simple movements, foot patterns and travelling.

CLASS 2

VEIL ease: Classic veil movements and "tricks", as well as entrance wraps, graceful unwraps, and discards.

Cassandra has focused her dance study and performance on the Egyptian Raks Sharqi and Middle Eastern folkloric dances since 1974. Her serious studies began in San Francisco with the legendary performer, Jamila Salimpour, and have continued since 1980 through regular research trips to the Middle East. Cassandra began her career as a cabaret performer, and her work in this area of Oriental Dance continued until 2010.

Since 1984, she has widened the scope of her artistic expression by presenting the dance on the theater stage. In 1989, Cassandra founded Jawaahir Dance Company, dedicated to bringing the rich folkloric heritage of the Middle East to the theater stage as a living art form. She is currently serving as Artistic Director and choreographer for the Company. Cassandra is a past recipient of the Minnesota Dance Alliance/McKnight Foundation Resident Choreographer's Award, as well as the MDA/Jerome Foundation Sponsor Pool and Dancer Pool Awards. She taught Arabic women's dances as adjunct faculty through University College at the University of Minnesota for 15 years.

Since 1992, she has been on the short and prestigious list of the Minneapolis Southern Theater's presented artists. Cassandra teaches and performs world-wide, and has earned an international reputation as an Oriental dance teacher, researcher, and performer. She regularly offers workshops, concerts and master classes worldwide, teaching and performing regularly in locations such as Cairo, Egypt, Marrakesh, Morocco, as well as Finland, Great Britain, Germany, Austria, New Zealand, and throughout the United States and Canada.
